



## Plastic Waste Management (Amendment) Rules, 2024

#### **Rule 17 Annual reports -**

- Every person engaged in recycling or processing of plastic waste shall prepare and submit online an annual report in Form-IV to the local body concerned and also to the State Pollution Control Board or Pollution Control Committee concerned by the **30th April of every year.**
- Every urban local body and panchayat at district level shall prepare and submit online an annual report in Form –V to the Urban Development Department and to Rural Development Department, respectively, and also to the **State**Pollution Control Board or Pollution Control Committee concerned by the **30th June every year.**
- The State Pollution Control Board or Pollution Control Committee concerned shall cause the report submitted by the
  urban local body and Panchayat at District level to be audited by itself or through a designated agency and copy of the
  report of such audit and the annual report shall be made available on website of State Pollution Control Board or
  Pollution Control Committee concerned.
- The State Pollution Control Board or Pollution Control Committee shall prepare and submit online an **annual report in**Form VI to the Central Pollution Control Board on the implementation of these rules by the **31st July of every year**.




### Introduction to National SUP Dashboard

The National SUP Dashboard, developed by Ministry of Environment Forest and Climate Change (MoEFCC) is a centralised platform. Facilitating digital submission of Annual Reports by ULBs, District Panchayats, SPCB/PCC, Recyclers in accordance with PWM regulations and providing comprehensive data on plastic pollution in India, thereby enabling actionable insights



## Reporting by ULBs and District Panchayats

- As per PWM (Amendment) Rules, 2024 every urban local body (ULB) has to prepare and submit online an annual report in Form –V A and every Panchayat at District Level (DP) has to prepare and submit online an annual report in Form –V B.
- These Forms are to be submitted to State Pollution Control Board or Pollution Control Committee and also to Urban Development Department (UDD) and Rural Development Department (RDD) respectively by the **30th June every year.**








